

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CARDIOLOGY UPDATE

In-line with NICE guidelines, on occasion, we require a cardiology opinion for the best management for safe prescribing of ADHD treatment if a patient presents with previous cardiac history, or on some occasions family history.

Unfortunately, our service does not currently have access to the e-referral platform to submit cardiology requests for advice and guidance directly. We are working hard to resolve this.
